#### Agreement on ASEAN Medical Device Directive (AMDD) Signed by Ministry of Member states on 21 Nov.,2014

#### **ARTICLE 14**

#### **INSTITUTIONAL ARRANGEMENTS**

(1) <u>The AMDC</u> shall be established with the overall responsibility of coordinating, reviewing and monitoring the implementation of this Agreement and shall comprise representatives from the Regulatory Authority of each Member State.

1	Brunei Darussalam	- Medical Device Order submitted for approval and targeting to be fully implemented in 2022
2	Cambodia	- Draft AMDD already submitted to the Council Minister and expected to be ready by 2019
3	Indonesia	<ul> <li>The ratification of AMDD is targeted by the end of 2019.</li> <li>The current regulation on Medical device is already in line with AMDD</li> </ul>
4	Lao PDR	- AMDD has been ratified on 25 May 2015
5	Malaysia	<ul> <li>Mandatory period for Product Registration has started on 1 July,2016</li> <li>Final draft of the second part of regulations has been finalized on 6 March,2017.</li> <li>Target for completion of ratification process by 2019</li> </ul>
6	Philippines	<ul> <li>Submission for ratification in 2018</li> <li>Implementation of the guideline in 2019</li> </ul>
7	Singapore	<ul> <li>Instrument of ratification has been submitted to the ASEAN sec. on 10 Nov 2015</li> <li>Has fully implemented AMDD</li> </ul>
